Special Regular Meeting of Aurora Council

A regular special meeting was called to order by Mayor Gregor at 5:30 p.m.

Item 4.1 was moved from new business to be addressed first.

Moved by Worshek and supported by Jofs to authorize Bolton & Menk to proceed with advertisement and bidding of Wastewater Digester Project. Motion carried unanimously.

A concerned citizen of Aurora brought forward questions regarding water treatment and storage.

City Administrator Lammi went over agenda format items and explained the information included. She would like the council to consider options as to what information they would like to receive to make informed decisions. No action taken.

The possibility of changing meeting times was discussed. No action taken.

The regular special meeting was closed pursuant to Minnesota Statue 13D.03 at 6:13 pm to discuss union negotiation strategy. The City Council came out of closed session at 6:58 pm. No action was taken during closed session.

Discussion took place regarding the possibility of starting a Blight Committee. Gregor is looking at extending invitations to community members, the East Range Police Department, Hoyt Lakes, and other concerned parties to attend a meeting in March. No action taken.

Moved by Gregor and supported by Honkola to add exceptions to the Community Center Policy for non-profits to not charge a rental fee to 501(c)3 organizations or Patriotic Days, Pumpkin Fest, or Holiday Heritage activities. Motion carried unanimously.

Discussion took place regarding transparency and pigeons. No action taken.

Moved by Worshek and supported by Honkola to adjourn the meeting. Motion carried unanimously. Meeting adjourned at 7:20 p.m.
