SPECIAL MEETING OF THE AURORA CITY COUNCIL
CITY/TOWN GOVERNMENT CENTER
MONDAY, JUNE 25, 2018
5:30 p.m.

PRESENT: Councilor Worshek, Gregor, Cromley, Lakso, Mayor Lislegard

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Lislegard at 5:30 p.m.

Hillary Hartleben was present representing Celebrate Aurora. Ms. Hartleben explained that despite the city council approving the use of a petting zoo in the vacant lot between the hair salon and the post office during the Patriotic Day celebrations, the vendor of the petting zoo did not have insurance. As a result, Celebrate Aurora had to abandon that plan and would like to use the space for various yard games instead.

Moved by Cromley and supported by Gregor to approve the request by Celebrate Aurora to use the city-owned empty lot next to the post office for yard games during the Patriotic Day celebrations contingent on additional fill being added to the lot by the public works department to make the lot safe for foot traffic. MOTION CARRIED

Moved by Worshek and supported by Gregor to approve the pay equity job points for the City Clerk at 350 points. MOTION CARRIED

Moved by Lislegard and supported by Lakso to approve the starting wage for the new City Clerk at \$31.25 per hour and increasing the rate after a six-month probationary period to \$32.25 per hour with all of the benefits per the non-union contract starting on the day of hire. MOTION CARRIED

Moved by Lislegard and supported by Worshek to approve the recommendation of the Interview Committee to extend a contingent offer to Rebecca Lammi for the City Clerk position subject to all of the applicable background checks, pre-employment physical, and drug testing. MOTION CARRIED

Moved by Cromley and supported by Lislegard to adjourn the meeting.
