ORDINANCE NO. 63, 1<sup>st</sup> SERIES

An ordinance of the City of Aurora, Minnesota, amending City Code, Title XV, Chapter 153: Zoning, Section 153.111, by amending provisions relating to ADULT ORIENTED ESTABLISHMENTS and by adopting by reference City Code Chapter 10 and Section 153.99, which among other things contain penalty provisions.


The City Council of the City of Aurora, Minnesota ordains:

**Section 153.111. ADULT ORIENTED ESTABLISHMENTS** is hereby amended by changing the following:

**ADULT USES (ACCESSORY).** The offering of goods and/or services classified as adult uses on a limited scale that are incidental to the primary activity and goods and/or services offered by the establishment. Examples of these items include adult magazines, adult movies, adult novelties, and the like. Accessory uses that use less than 200 square feet or 10% of the total floor area (square footage), whichever is less, are exempted from obtaining a license under this subchapter.


This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval and publication as provided by law.
