

**CITY OF AURORA
ORDINANCE NO. 66**

An ordinance of the City of Aurora, Minnesota, amending City Code, Title V, Chapter 50: Utilities Generally, Section 50.13, Paragraph B (5) by amending provisions relating to BILLING, PAYMENT & DELINQUENCY

The City Council of the City of Aurora, Minnesota ordains:

§ 50.15 BILLING, PAYMENT AND DELINQUENCY.

B (5) When it becomes necessary for the city to discontinue utility service to a customer for nonpayment of bills, service will be reinstated only after all bills for service then due have been paid, along with a turn-on charge, with said charge to be set by resolution of the City Council.

This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval and publication as provided by law.
